Requirements for Admission:

1. Students must satisfy one of the following:
 - a. Matriculation in a graduate program at the University of Washington, or
 - b. Admittance as a non-matriculated (non-degree seeking) graduate-level student.
2. Students must have taken one semester of calculus and received a grade of B (3.0) or above, and at least six quarters (four semesters) of undergraduate or graduate coursework in geophysical science, physics, or chemistry, also with an average grade of B (3.0) or above.
3. For UW graduate **non-matriculated** students, GRE mathematics, verbal, and analytical scores all at or above the 75th percentile are required for consideration.
4. For students **matriculated in a UW department other than Atmospheric Sciences, Oceanography or Earth and Space Sciences**, we require a letter of concurrence from that department's Graduate Program Coordinator.
