Funding from the Program on Climate Change for Publication and Regional Travel Costs Associated with GCeCS Capstone Projects

The Graduate Certificate in Climate Change (GCeCS) requires a capstone project that focuses on communicating climate science. To support the dissemination of the outcomes of these capstone efforts, the Program on Climate Change has two new opportunities.

Support for publication costs. Capstone projects sometimes lead to publications that are outside the scope of home department degree program requirements. The PCC may support up to 50% of publication costs for papers that have come out of capstone projects and are unrelated to the disciplinary degree research or project requirements (i.e. M.S. thesis or capstone, PhD dissertation). These will be evaluated on a case by case basis; the PCC will award up to 3 a year and not more than \$1500 per publication. A student may only receive this award once.

To apply, please write a one to two page justification for support. Include a title and an abstract of the paper that you intend to submit for publication and address the following:

- a) How this work is distinct from your degree project/thesis
- b) Where the paper will be submitted and estimated costs
- c) Why there is a need for funding

Support for travel related to capstone projects. The PCC supports modest travel costs for active PCC participants to give climate-related outreach presentations that engage regional audiences (non-airline travel) beyond UW. This support is also available to all GCeCS students delivering capstone presentations. Support will be determined on a case by case basis. To apply please articulate the following:

- a) The audience that you will be serving
- b) The venue/location, topic and format of the engagement
- c) Estimated costs
